1. **Question:** - What is Pathophysiology of restrictive cardiomyopathy? (Dr. A.K. Deshpande, Assoc. Professor of Pathology)

Answer: - Impaired diastolic filling due to infiltration of ventricles with raised ED pressure, with atrial enlargement leading to AF (Dr. Satya Srinivas A, Asst. Professor of General Medicine)
2. **Question:** - What is importance of Eosinophil count in RCM? (Dr. A.K. Deshpande, Assoc. Professor of Pathology).

Answer: It will detect Hypereosinophilic cardiomyopathy. (Dr. Satya Srinivas Appala, Asst. Professor of General Medicine).
3. **Question:** - What is the duration of usage of diuretics in RCM? (Dr. C. Soren, Assoc. Professor of Paediatrics).

Answer: Till the volume overload is corrected. If prolonged use of diuretics then add K⁺ sparing diuretics to loop diuretics (Dr. Satya Srinivas Appala, Asst. Professor of General Medicine).
