1. **Question:** - How do we differentiate clinically restrictive cardiomyopathy from constructive pericarditis? (Dr. Sowjanya, Final year PG in General Medicine).  
**Answer:** - The differentiation in constrictive pericarditis, we find calcified and thickening of pericardium in CT scan, which is not found in restrictive cardiomyopathy - (Dr. M. Sindhu, PG in General Medicine).
2. **Question:** - How do you diagnosis HOCM clinically? (Dr. Y.S. Kanni, Professor & HOD of General Medicine).  
**Answer:** - Presence of systemic murmurs in mitral area - (Dr. M. Sindhu, PG in General Medicine).
3. **Question:** - How clinical diagnosis of HOCM even if there is no murmur in aortic area? (Dr. S. Mohd Ali, Professor of General Medicine).  
**Answer:** - Not essential to have Aortic murmur but presence of murmur in mitral area (systolic murmur) which increase on "Valselva method" - (Dr. Sindhu, PG in General Medicine).
4. **Question:** - What is ablation method for AF? (Dr. B.R.K. Rao, Professor of Ophthalmology).  
**Answer:** - It is T / T of choice when patient does not respond to medical therapy - (Dr. Satya Srinivas Appala, Asst. Professor of General Medicine).
