- **LIFELONG LEARNER**: Committed to continuous improvement of skills and knowledge, continue learning, refine existing skills and acquire new skills.
- **PROFESSIONAL**: Who is committed to excellence, is ethical, responsive and accountable to patients, community and profession.

- > Recognize health for all as a national goal and health right for all citizens.
- Learn get acquainted on every aspect of national health policies and its implementation.
- Achieve competence in practice of holistic medicine, encompassing promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative aspects of common diseases.
- Develop scientific temper, acquire educational experience for proficiency in profession and promote healthy living.
- Become an exemplary citizen by observance of medical ethics and fulfilling social and professional obligation
